



What's New With OneCare?

CalOptima Health now offers two Medicare Advantage Special Needs Plans for seniors and people with disabilities who qualify for both Medicare and Medi-Cal.^{1,2} For the 2025 contract year, there are some drug changes and new benefits as described below.

OneCare &more Card Supplemental Benefit

OTC drugs are not covered by Medicare Part D.³ Medi-Cal may cover some OTC drugs but not all. With no out-of-pocket costs, OneCare members receive a quarterly allowance to spend on eligible groceries and OTC health and wellness items through the new OneCare &more card benefit. A prescription is not required for OTC items obtained through the OneCare &more card. Eligible groceries include but are not limited to fresh produce, whole foods and canned foods. Members can shop at participating stores or place OTC orders online or over the phone. Limitations apply.

Prescription Drug Coverage

Most prescription drugs are covered by Medicare Part D, but some prescription drugs or their indications are excluded from Medicare and Medi-Cal coverage. One such excluded indication is the treatment of erectile dysfunction (ED).³ OneCare Flex Plus will offer enhanced coverage for the treatment of ED. This enhanced drug benefit includes up to four generic sildenafil tablets per month.
