

Medi-Cal Enrollment for Newborns

If you become pregnant and are receiving Medi-Cal benefits you may contact the County of Orange Social Services Agency (SSA) office to report your pregnancy.

Notifying SSA when the child is born will simplify the enrollment process and ensure that you and your baby obtain appropriate Medi-Cal coverage, including postpartum care. You will need to provide your newborn's first and last name, date of birth and gender.

It is important to apply for a Social Security card with the Social Security Administration by calling 800-281-9799, applying online at www.ssa.gov or visiting your local Social Security Administration office.

You will need to provide a copy of the Social Security card to your SSA eligibility worker once you receive it.

Your newborn can be added to your case via phone call, visiting your local SSA office, online through the MyBenefitsCalWIN portal or by completing and mailing or faxing the Newborn Referral Form MC330 at <https://ssa.ocgov.com/health-care-services/medi-cal-program-services/newborn-referral>
